Meet Jonathan . . .



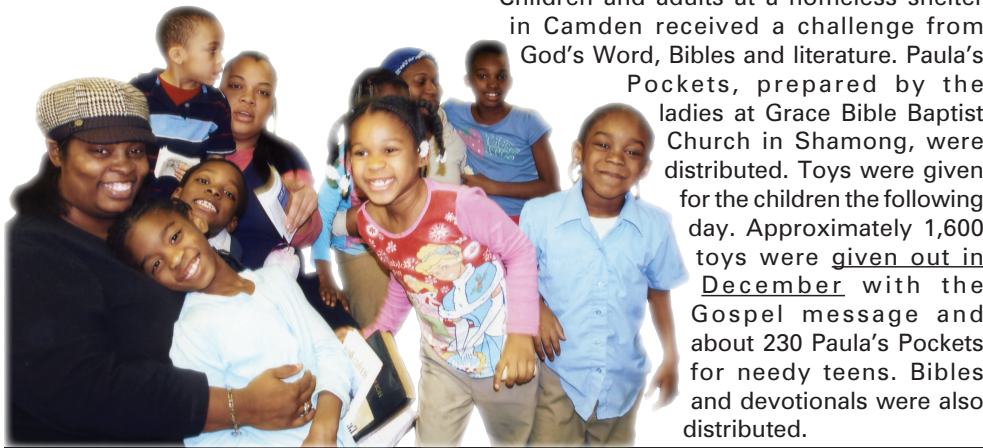
